



## Beginner Wreck Diving

### Join Woodbridge Scuba, June 4 & 5, 2011 to dive the Wrecks near Morehead City, NC

Just off the coast of Morehead City, NC Head lays the Graveyard of the Atlantic. Wrecks ranging from the colonial period through the late 20<sup>th</sup> century rest on the Continental shelf. These wrecks make for great wreck diving. Next to Truk (Chuuk) Lagoon in the Pacific, the Graveyard of the Atlantic is rated as the best wreck diving in the world. As a way of initiating new divers and “pretty fish and coral” divers to North Carolina wreck diving, we plan the “Beginner Wreck Diving” Weekend. On a regular NC wreck diving trip, we would visit a deep wreck (up to 130 feet) followed by a more shallow dive on an “In Shore” wreck (60-90 feet). During the “Beginner Wreck Diving” weekend, we will only dive the “In Shore” wrecks. After gaining confidence on the “In shore” wrecks, our divers have the confidence and experience necessary to return and dive the deeper wrecks, such as, the U-352.

These will be recreational dives to a maximum depth of about 90 feet. These dives are recommended for recreational divers. No wreck diving experience is required. We will dive both Saturday and Sunday, weather permitting. Cost of dives will be \$230 per diver per weekend plus a possible fuel charge. Divers will be expected to dive both Saturday and Sunday. Divers will be responsible for own accommodations – Discovery Diving offers divers the use of their bunkhouse. You can dive the wrecks on regular air, but you will have more bottom time if you dive it on NITROX. The local dive shop banks 32% NITROX and will custom mix NITROX as requested. Get your Nitrox Training at Woodbridge Scuba.

**Required Equipment:** Two Tanks (Filled), Regulator w/alternate regulator, Buoyancy Compensator, Weights and Weight Belt, Wetsuit – (at least 6MM), Air Gauge, Depth Gauge, Bottom Timer or Computer, Dive Tables, Knife, Certification Card(s), Logbook, Surface Signaling device.

**Recommended Equipment:** Alternate Air Source, Wreck Reel, Lift Bag, Underwater light, Gloves, Hood, Sea Sick Medicine, Camera, Save-A-Dive kit, Dry Bag, Slate, Lunch/drinks, Sunglasses, Sunscreen, Hat, Warm Clothes, Towel, Redundant Light, Dive Insurance.

You will be responsible for all of your own transportation to Morehead City, NC, as well as to the dock each morning. U-boat Diving, Wreck Diving, Low visibility and Nitrox Classroom classes are available through Woodbridge Scuba.
